Various Roads, Barming in the Borough of Maidstone - Amendment 16: Waiting restrictions

The effect of this proposed Order would be to place double yellow lines on the following length of roads in Barming, Boxley and Maidstone: - . Abbots Field – On both sides of its junction with Fant Lane for a distance of 11 metres in a north easterly direction.; Ash Grove – On the north side to a point 15 metres west and to a point 15 metres east of its junction with Conway Road.
