Maths



Measure the perimeter (the distance all the way around the walls) of each room in your house. Estimate (take a good guess) which room you think has the greatest perimeter and then check if you're right with a tape measure, or maybe in pigeon steps. Could you be creative with what items you use to measure? Could you convert your measurements from metres to centimetres? Take pictures as you go along.

Create a robot using empty boxes and bottles. Can you make the tallest robot or one that has moveable parts? Think about decorating the items as they become parts of your robot.
