Young people in KS1 to KS4 should:

- Write or record a piece of creative writing in 500 words or less - based on the subject "a wonderful world"
- Their creative piece can be about their own world, a far away place, outer space, an imaginary land, a piece of nature or a time in history, in fact, anything at all - the choice is theirs!
- It can be a traditional story format, a poem, a comic strip or any other way of expressing their work to us!
- It can be work completed in school as part of a classroom exercise, homework or something worked on independently at home. We can't wait to see what our young writers of 2024 create.
